






**B.** Leg - Bottom x4


## **WARNING**


#### **HIGH CHAIR USE**


- FALL HAZARD: Children have suffered severe head injuries including skull fractures when falling from high chairs. Falls can happen suddenly if child is not restrained properly.
- Always use restraints, and adjust to fit snugly.
- Tray is not designed to hold child in chair.
- Stay near and watch child during use.
- Never leave child unattended.
- The child should be secured in the high chair at all times by the restraint system.
- It is recommended that the high chair be used only by children capable of sitting upright unassisted.
- Always place the high chair on a horizontal, stable surface. Do not move chair with child in it.
- In High Chair mode, the high chair is recommended for children who can sit upright unassisted OR weigh over 20 lbs (9 kg) and are not more than 36 months old or 40 lbs (18 kg).



- When using the high chair, do not place your child near objects that he or she can push against to overturn the high chair.
- Do not use the product if any part is broken, torn, or missing.
- Ensure that all components are correctly fitted and adjusted before use.
- To avoid the danger of suffocation, remove all plastic covers before using the product.
- Do not leave the product near walls, curtains, or windows, where the child can become entangled.
- Do not attach any parts to the product that are not supplied or expressly approved by Chicco.









3. Attach 1 Leg into one of the Front attachment openings on the High Chair Seat (C). Push in on the Pin and slide the Leg into the High Chair Seat, as shown. The Leg is securely attached when the pin on the Leg is engaged.



# 5. Slide the remaining Leg up through the other Footrest opening. Press in on the top pin to allow the Leg to slide up through the Footrest (A) until it reaches the opening on the seat bottom. Press in on the top pin again and insert the Leg into the to seat bottom. Push up until the pin engages (B). Press in on the lower pin and pull the Footrest down until the pin engages (C). B. "CLICK!" C. "CLICK!"







#### **Adjusting Safety Harness**

#### **AWARNING**

Prevent serious injury or death from sliding out, falls, or tipping over. Always secure child in the restraint. Never leave child unattended. The tray is not designed to hold the child in the chair.









Make sure the Shoulder Strap Connector is in the correct position, as shown. Slide the Shoulder Strap Connector onto the Waist Strap Clip and repeat for the other side.

Then slide both Waist Clips into the Crotch Strap Buckle as shown. Pull on both sides to make sure the Clips are secured to the Buckle.




#### **Adjusting Safety Harness**



9. The safety harness can be released by pressing the button on the center of the Crotch Strap Buckle and pulling both Waist Clips out.


Pull on the Shoulder Strap Connector to remove it from the Waist Strap Clip.






10. The length of the Shoulder Straps and Crotch Strap can be adjusted by pulling on the adjustment buckles to tighten or loosen.

The length of the Waist Straps can be adjusted by pressing the tab at the end of the Waist Strap Clip and pulling on the strap to tighten or loosen to better fit your child.



#### **Tray Use**




12. The Tray can be adjusted to 3 different positions.

To adjust the Tray squeeze both Tray Locks on each side of the Tray and slide it forward or backwards.


The Tray can be removed by squeezing both Tray Locks on each side of the Tray and lifting up.

#### **Tray Storage**




13. Pull out on both Tray Locks underneath the Tray. Line up the Tray Lock with the storage lock on the back of the seat where the rear legs attach, as shown. Release the Tray Locks and make sure the Locks click into place on both sides.


**NOTE:** Tray cannot be stored on the rear when in Feeding Chair mode.






### YOUTH STOOL & TODDLER CHAIR USE

- Do not attach any parts to the product that are not supplied or expressly approved by Chicco.




# 21 21. To remove Shoulder Straps from the Seat Back: Flatten the Shoulder Strap Tab and push it through the slot in the Seat and Seat Pad. Repeat for other Shoulder Strap.

#### **Removing the Harness**



22. Loosen the folded webbing Waist Belt tab and white ribbon Seat Pad tab by pulling them both out of the slot in the back of the Seat. Flatten the white ribbon Seat Pad tab and feed it through the slot in the back of the Seat. Then flatten the harness webbing Waist Belt tab and feed it through the same slot.


**NOTE:** To Re-attach the Seat Pad with the Waist Belt follow this step in reverse. Making sure that both straps are secured in the seat back opening.



#### **Removing the Harness**


# **Bottom View of Seat** 23. From the bottom of the Seat: pull the folded end of the Crotch Strap out of the slot. Flatten the Crotch Strap and feed it back into the slot. From the top of the Seat: Pull on the Crotch Strap to remove it from the Seat and the Seat Pad. To attach the Seat Pad WITHOUT the Harness refer to Step 24. To attach the Seat Pad WITH the Harness refer to Step 25A.


#### **Attaching the Seat Pad - WITHOUT Harness**



24. Insert BOTH the white Seat Pad ribbon and the Seat Pad webbing though the waist belt opening in the back of the seat.


Fold both attachment strap wings together on both straps. Stack the straps and pull firmly on the straps from the front of the seat to secure the tabs into the opening.





Pull firmly on the white ribbon and webbing to secure.


#### **Attaching the Seat Pad - WITH Harness**



**NOTE:** Use ONLY the thin white ribbon on the Seat Pad to attach the Seat Pad WITH the harness.


25A. Insert the Waist Belt Strap attachment tab through the waist belt slot in the Seat Pad and the back of the seat.

#### **Attaching the Seat Pad - WITH Harness**




25B. Insert the white ribbon attachment tab through the waist belt opening in the back of the seat. Fold both attachment strap wings together on both straps. Stack the straps and pull firmly on the straps from the front of the seat to secure the tabs into the opening.





Pull firmly on the white ribbon and webbing to secure.


#### **YOUTH STOOL WITHOUT Footrest**



26. The Youth Stool may be used with or without the Footrest (D). To remove the Footrest, follow Steps 15-16.

Re-attach the Leg that was removed by pressing in on the top pin and re-inserting the Leg into the bottom of the Seat. The Leg is securely attached when the pin on the leg is engaged.

#### **TODDLER CHAIR Mode**





**NOTE:** If the Youth Stool was used with the Footrest installed, please remove it before using in Toddler Chair Mode. To remove Footrest refer to Steps 15-16.

27. To convert Youth Stool to Toddler Chair Mode remove the Leg - Bottoms (B) by pushing in on the pins and sliding all 4 Legs apart.

The Toddler Chair may be used with or without the Seat Pad. To Install the Seat Pad without the Harness, follow Steps 24.



#### **Cleaning and Maintenance**

This product requires regular maintenance. The cleaning and maintenance of the product must only be carried out by an adult.

#### **CLEANING**

Periodically wipe clean plastic parts with a soft damp cloth. You can spot clean the Seat Pad and Harness webbing with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Always dry the metal parts to prevent the formation of rust if the product has come into contact with water. Do not use bleach, spray, or wipes on the product. Do NOT fully submerge Tray in water. Tray is NOT dishwasher safe.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

Periodically check the product for loose screws, or worn parts. Replace or repair the parts as needed. Use only Chicco replacement parts. To avoid friction that may prevent the correct operation of the product, ensure that all the movable plastic parts placed along the metal frame are clean of dust and dirt. Keep product in a dry place. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight may cause the plastic parts to warp.
